### NOTES

- Walking Distance** – Shortest-walking route between your home and the delineated area school, ie 2 mile for primary school and 3 miles for secondary schools.
- Medical** – Requests for transport on medical grounds should be referred to the school who will arrange for the school medical officer to examine your child.
- Safety** – If there is no reasonable safe walking route between your home and the school, please note that we will make a decision after checking with the Roads Department.
- Placing Requests** – Please note that if your child attends a school by means of a placing request you are responsible for arranging transport to school.
- Privileged** – Should you wish to be considered for a privileged space, application should be made before 20 September each year. Allocation of seats will be carried out in accordance with North Ayrshire Council's transport policy and will not be allocated before October each year. Spaces will be granted only where there is spare seats to pupils attending their delineated area school on school walking distance in the first instance and then thereafter to pupils outwith the delineated area by ballot if at no additional cost to the Council.
