




Eglinton Country Park

Eglinton is the 34th registered Country Park in Scotland. The Park was developed around the ancient Eglinton Estate, home for 600 years to the Earls of Eglinton and Winton. Our Visitor Centre has an exhibition on the history of the area including the fascinating story of the Eglinton Tournament. This year the newly re-opened Tournament Café has provided a welcome stop for visitors with high quality wholesome foods to suit all tastes. We also have a new state of the art play facility for the under 8's. The principal objective of the Country Park is to provide, within a countryside setting, facilities for outdoor recreation which allow the inhabitants of North Ayrshire and surrounding areas to enjoy visits to the countryside while gaining an appreciation and understanding of their local environment.

This is achieved by maintaining and enhancing the natural qualities of the Park, such as its quiet, rural parkland character, and the opportunities it can provide for peacefulness and solitude, its flora, fauna, geology and geomorphology and its historic buildings and evidence of earlier ways of life. At the same time careful provision is made for passive recreational pursuits such as walking, cycling, picnicking and horse riding, along with larger countryside related events within the estate boundaries.
