Clyde Muirshiel Regional Park


Clyde Muirshiel is Scotland's largest regional park offering a range of recreational opportunities. The park has moorlands and woodlands, lochs and rivers, paths and trails for both gentle relaxation and something more strenuous. The Regional Park Ranger Service patrols routes, runs events and advises visitors to the Regional Park.

This is the countryside on your doorstep. Access points to Clyde Muirshiel Regional Park include the visitor centres and country parks at Muirshiel, Castle Semple and Cornalees; the Core Paths; the National Cycle Route 7; the network of minor roads (some of them Core Paths) and the public transport system with railway stations ringing the park.


The central area of the regional park is a Special Protection Area for Hen Harriers and you may be fortunate to see their "skydancing" displays in the spring. There are also a variety of other visitor attractions and facilities including Castles and wildlife reserves within the regional park.
