Therefore, I give public notice that Irene Campbell is duly elected as the Member of Parliament for the North Ayrshire and Arran constituency.

The total number of votes cast across North Ayrshire and Arran at the UK Parliamentary election on 4th July 2024 was 42,423.

The total number of ballot papers rejected was 161

The ballot papers were rejected for the following reasons:

- 0 ballot papers were rejected because they did not bear the official mark
- 15 ballot papers were rejected because votes were given for more than one candidate
- 0 ballot papers were rejected because there was something written or marked on the ballot paper by which the voter could be identified
- 146 ballot papers were rejected because they were unmarked or void for uncertainty
