# North Ayrshire Council can help you if you are struggling to make ends meet.

If you are in crisis and need support, please call the Council's Customer Services team on 01294 310000. The Council's expert teams can advise you on:



#### **Energy Support Payment**

Helps people struggling to pay energy bills who have had no support through Cost-of-Living payments OR are at risk of being cut off. We can also refer you to Home Energy Scotland for additional advice and, possibly, further financial support.



#### Scottish Welfare Fund

Offers support for residents on low income/qualifying benefits who have suffered a disaster or emergency. If the Fund isn't suitable, food bank vouchers may be available.



#### **Clothing Grant & Free School Meals**

Payments issued directly to parents during the school holidays. Means-tested free school meals for children in low-income households.



#### **Council Tax Reduction**

Council Tax Reduction scheme (CTR) helps people on a low income pay all, or part, of their Council Tax. To qualify you need to be on a low income and be responsible for paying Council Tax.



#### **Discretionary Housing Payment**

If you claim Housing Benefit or receive housing cost payments through Universal Credit and need financial help because your benefit is less than the full amount of your rent, DHP can help cover this. If you get Housing Benefit or Universal Credit you can claim a DHP to help pay your rent. You can also visit the Council's Customer Service Centres in person to chat to an adviser.
