(Pedestrian Priority) Temporary No.3 Order 2022

The North Ayrshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 14(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "**The North Ayrshire Council (Dockhead Street, Saltcoats) (Pedestrian Priority) Temporary No.3 Order 2022**" and shall come into operation from **25th April 2022** and shall remain in operation for eighteen months until **25th October 2023**.

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

"1984 Order" means The Strathclyde Regional Council (Dockhead Street, Saltcoats) (Pedestrian Priority) Order 1984.

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000 as subsequently amended or varied;

"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle lawfully displaying a disabled persons' badge in the relevant position.

3. The 1984 Order shall be temporarily amended for the duration of this Order as follows:
 - (i) In Column II of Schedule 1 to the 1984 Order, the times "10.30 to 16.30" on each occasion where they appear shall be deleted and the times "**10:00 to 16:00**" shall be inserted in their place. The effect of this amendment is that:
 - (a) save as provided in the 1984 Order as hereinafter amended, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle or cause or permit any vehicle to remain at rest on any of the lengths of the roads specified in Column 1 of Schedule I to the 1984 Order during the hours of **10:00 to 16:00**;
 - (b) **the hours of 10.00 to 16.00 shall be the prohibited hours for the purposes of the 1984 Order.**
 - (ii) In Part IV of the 1984 Order, Article 9 (i) shall be revoked.

The effect of this amendment is to remove the exemption for a disabled person's vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge, so that a disabled person's vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge is not permitted to use the roads specified in Column 1 of Schedule I to the 1984 Order during the prohibited hours.

4. The Council consider it is necessary to make this Order as they are satisfied that traffic on the affected roads should be restricted or prohibited for the reason specified in Section 14(1)(b) of the Act, being the likelihood of danger to the public.

5. As specified above, Article 9 (i) of the 1984 Order is hereby temporarily suspended and the prohibited hours temporarily amended for the duration of this Order. Subject to these changes, the 1984 Order shall remain in full force and effect.
