

Training outlines:

Level 1

A half day awareness raising course, helping participants to recognise adults at risk of harm and their responsibilities to report. Suitable for all care or support staff working directly with adult service users or members of the community or public.

Level 2

A one day course extending understanding of the legislation, and the range of responsibilities and duties. Suitable for managers or any senior staff responsible for the practice of others.

Train the Trainer

1½ day course for managers or senior staff, to equip them with the skills to cascade a short 1½ hour adult protection training course to care, support or volunteer staff within their service. Attendance on ASP Level 2 is mandatory before attending this event

Financial Harm for Awareness

Half day course, to build understanding of the financial exploitation of service users who may be at risk of financial harm in care settings and/or living in the community, and to consider the relevance of appropriate legislation. For all staff.

Self Neglect Awareness

Half day course to build understanding of adults who self neglect while living in the community or in a care setting. Focuses on recognising the signs and links to appropriate legislation. For all staff.
