Tip: you can follow the grid below to help you get started with a viking ship shape - but feel free to get creative! You can work by yourself or with others, but be careful not to destroy anyone else's ship.

Wool blocks can be used to create colourful sails



Fences can be used for the mast



Frames can be used for shields on the side of the ship



Combine different wood plank blocks to create interesting shapes
